Thank you so much incoming Rotary leader of District 3080."




Three Rotary International Presidents visit Nevedac Prosthetic Centre on 10th January 1998





The International Society for Prosthetics and Orthotics (ISPO) has decided to hold the ISPO 18th World Congress planned for 1 to 4 November 2021 as a virtual event and not on site in Mexico.

ISPO puts the health and safety of participants, presenters, exhibitors, and staff at the highest priority. Therefore, the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has made an in-person 2021 World Congress in Guadalajara unviable.

To secure global knowledge exchange and give professionals involved in the care of persons in need of prosthetic, orthotic, mobility, and assistive devices the opportunity to connect, a virtual event will be organised by ISPO International. Details will be published on the World Congress website at www.ispo-congress.com as they become available.

We recognise the importance of having an in-person event in Latin America. Therefore, in collaboration with ISPO Mexico, ISPO Canada, and US-ISPO, the ISPO World Congress will meet in Guadalajara in April 2023, once the world's health and economic situations have strengthened.

On 16 May 2021, in an another initiative to reach public during the current pandemic and address the current crisis Rotary Chandigarh Midtown in association with Besure Buddy Cabs and Haryana State Legal Services Authority (HALSA) inaugurated *Oxygen on Wheels* from the Administrative Building of HALSA, Sector 14, Chandigarh. Hon'ble Mr. Justice Rajan Gupta, Judge, Punjab and Haryana High Court and Executive Chairman, Haryana State Legal Services Authority inaugurated *Oxygen on Wheels*, a project started with an aim to provide necessary relief to the persons in need.

This project will give first mile connectivity before a patient gets proper treatment. Under this project, the Cabs - modified into Oxygen Cylinder fitted Cabs, with all Covid safety Protocols, will run in tricity to cater the needs of the Covid Patients exclusively by transporting them to the hospitals in emergency with Oxygen backup or providing them Oxygen inhaling at their doorstep.

Kulvinder Singh, a 15 year old boy, a super human was under prosthetic treatment of Dr. V.J.S. Vohra. Kulvinder had all four limbs amputation due to electric shocks while offering kar sewa at Gurudwara in Derabasi (near Chandigarh).

He was provided Myo-facil prosthesis and a cosmetic prosthesis for his bilateral below elbow amputation at Otto Bock Healthcare, Mohali.

Now Kulvinder is walking with Otto Bock bilateral below knee artificial legs and carrying on his daily activities independently with prosthetic devices provided with financial support from Ms. Sukhy Randhawa of UK, Rotary Club Chandigarh Midtown, Ottobock and MLA N.K. Sharma of Zirakpur.

This shows that technology can make future bright for people with disabilities. Let us make it available for them.
